Eligibility of exhibitors and contestants: Only 4-H members of Montana are eligible to exhibit and compete in this department.

Entry deadline: Friday, June 25, 5 pm

Use 4-H entry forms from the Extension Office or from the 4-H division on montanastatefair.com. Do not use Montana State Fair forms.

PREMIUMS: Over \$7,000. Premiums paid to blue and red award winners. All members must complete a W9 form at time of entry to receive premiums.

INTERVIEW JUDGING: Interview schedules will be printed in the 4-H newsletter and available on the 4-H website. Members not present for their scheduled interview will not receive premium money unless previous arrangements are made. Members who will be absent from interview judging and would like to enter items must complete an Absentee Judging Form for each item and arrange for someone to bring the tagged items to the fair and pick them up after the fair. Forms are available

at the Extension Office. Members must leave all entry blanks with entry clerks or no premium money can be issued.

CLOVERBUDS: In keeping with the non-competitive guidelines of the Cloverbuds program, there will be no judging of Cloverbud projects. All projects, however, will be awarded a participation ribbon and may be displayed in the club booth. Cloverbuds may participate in an interview.

- g. Any necessary rule or schedule changes may be announced or posted by the superintendents.
- h. 4-H organizational leaders may collect premium monies from the Cascade County Extension Office approximately two weeks after the close of Montana State Fair.

General Rules

- a. 4-H members can enter exhibits only from projects in which they are currently enrolled. Exhibits must be the work of the 4-H member and made during the current 4-H Club year.
- b. Members may exhibit ONLY ONE ENTRY IN EACH CLASS. Each exhibit must be labeled with member's name, club and address.
- c. Bring general entry forms to interview judging with tagged entries. All exhibitors must submit a W9 form with entry form.
- d. Return all other entry forms to: Cascade County Extension Office, 1807 3rd St. NW, Great Falls, MT, 59404. Entry blanks must be obtained from the Extension Office. DO NOT USE Montana State Fair ENTRY FORMS ONLINE OR FROM FAIR OFFICE.
- e. There are separate entry forms for the following:
 - Horse Show
 - Rabbit Show
 - Poultry Show
 - Foods Festival/Edible Art
 - Pocket Pets
 - Cat Show
 - Speech/Demonstrations
 - Fashion Revue/Quilt ShowAll other entries are entered from the classes listed in the premium book using the 4-H General Entry Form and in the order listed in the premium book.
