General Rules

- All participants at Montana State Fair events are responsible for reading the General Information section of this handbook and complying with policies listed therein.
- AGREEMENT TO ALL RULES AND REGULATIONS HEREIN STATED IS UNDERSTOOD WHEN THE EXHIBITOR SUBMITS THE ENTRY FORM.
- All entrants must complete a W9 form at time of entry to receive premiums.**
- Youth 6-18 years may purchase a \$20 exhibitor's pass that includes 10 admissions—no vehicle. Ag-Ed adults may purchase a similar pass for \$25, which includes 10 adult admissions and/or a vehicle.
- All possible care will be exercised by State Fair in handling exhibits, but no responsibility for loss or damage in transit or during any phase of the exhibit will be assumed by State Fair.
- No entry fee.
- Advisors of FFA chapters and FFA members wearing their FFA jackets will be admitted to the Fair without charge on days when the livestock, soils, and range judging contests are held.
- This department is exclusively for regularly enrolled students in recognized Agriculture Education Departments in Montana. The members exhibiting or judging must be in good standing in their schools.
- Exhibitors in this department will be able to exhibit in other departments if eligible; however, a separate exhibit must be entered.
