**Original Art:** May be completed at home

2. Works must be delivered to Superintendent no later than 3 pm on July 27.
3. Contestants must agree to allow Pony Show to duplicate their work. These duplications could be used for thank you notes, publicity, etc.
4. Original art will be returned to contestants after the Fair.

**PREMIUMS:** All participants will receive a Montana State Fair ribbon. Awards will be given to three places.
