MONTANA STATE FAIR-SHOW #1

MONTANA STATE FAIR-SHOW #2

APA/ABA Sanction

- b. Premiums, ribbons and sanction points offered by this show.

REGULATIONS FOR SECTIONS 2-9

1. Completed entry forms, one per exhibitor, and entry fees made payable to Montana State Fair.

2. There will be a \$.50 charge for each change made on entry form on check-in day. Not listing band #s will constitute a change.
3. Substitutions will be allowed only if replacement bird is of the same breed, variety, age and sex as previous entry.
4. All birds must have leg bands to identify individuals.
5. Exhibitors are asked to dust their birds 7 days prior to check-in day at the Fair.
6. Handsome ribbons will be awarded in all regular classes on 1st thru 5th placings.

STANDARD POULTRY REGULATIONS:

1. All poultry will be judged in accordance with the current American Poultry Association Standard Of Perfection, copyrighted by the American Poultry Association.
2. To win American Poultry Association medals there must be 10 entries in each class. Competition is open to all entries; however, APA awards will be issued only to those winners who are members in good standing.
3. To become a member of APA: adults send \$15 for one year or \$40 for three years and juniors (under 18 years of age) send \$10 for one year: American Poultry Association, PO Box 306, Burgettstown, PA, 15021.

BANTAM POULTRY REGULATIONS:

1. Only members of the ABA are eligible for ABA awards. Winners of ABA awards are listed in the yearbook under who's who in bantams. Starred wins are earned by champions and reserve champions when the number of birds in the class is 100 or more. For definition of class see the following listing:
 - a. 7x9 plaque for champion and reserve champion of show
 - b. 5x7 plaque for best and reserve of class in classes of 50 or more birds competing
 - c. Certificates for best and reserve of class in classes of 25-49 birds competing
2. To join the ABA remit \$20 for one year (individual or family) or \$50 for three years. Those joining for one year get a free copy of the latest yearbook which features about 800 advertisers plus a complete breed and variety index. Send to: American Bantam Association, PO Box 127, Augusta, NJ 07822-0127.
3. A single bird cannot get more than one starred win at any one show, likewise a single bird is limited to winning one plaque; for example, should best feather leg be grand champion only one plaque will be issued to it.
