REGULATIONS FOR FLOCK ENTRIES:

1. FLOCK DESCRIPTION: One ram (any age), two ewes (yearling or older), and 2 lambs (ram or ewe); must be of same breed—need not be related
2. Competition will occur both in the show ring and in the sheep display area
3. Supreme Flock will be determined in the following manner:
 - a. The flock will be judged in the show ring. Points will be awarded by the judge. The quality of the animals presented will be scored relative to the standards of perfection of the breed.
 - b. Exhibitors will be expected to prepare and present a 2-3 minute explanation promoting the attributes of the breed, its contribution to the sheep and wool industry, and comments on the individuals shown.
 - c. Exhibitors will be observed in their pen areas and points will be awarded based on herdsmanship and the interaction with and education of the public.
 - d. Placings will be based on total points earned.
 - e. Flocks must receive a minimum of 60 points in order to qualify for premiums.

Flock Judging criteria will be:

- Quality of animals.....40 points
- Presentation in show ring.....20 points

Herdsmanship/

Interaction with public 20 points

Display/Promotional/

Public Relations 20 points

DIVISION 1: SUPREME FLOCK

ENTRY FEE: \$20 per flock

PEN FEE: \$5/pen (List # of pens on entry form)

PREMIUMS:

Less than 10 flocks: 1st-\$500; 2nd-\$300; 3rd-\$200;
4th-\$100

10 or more flocks: 1st-\$700; 2nd-\$500; 3rd-\$400;
4th-\$300; 5th-\$200; 6th-\$100

REGULATIONS FOR INDIVIDUAL ENTRIES:

1. Premium monies for Breed Champion Ewe and Ram will be paid only if there is a minimum of five (5) head presented by three (3) different owners in any one specific breed.
2. Quality of animals presented will be scored by judge and placing awarded.
3. Champions of the breed classes become eligible for the Supreme Ewe and Supreme Ram competition.
4. Breeds without a minimum of five head and three different owners will compete in an Open Breed competition. There will be no cross entering from breeds that are eligible for a specific breed show class.
5. Quality of animals presented will be scored relative to the standards of perfection of the breed.
6. Exhibitors need not enter a flock to compete in individual classes.

DIVISION 2-16: (see division list for breeds)

ENTRY FEE: \$10 per animal if individual; \$5 per animal if part of flock

PEN FEE: \$5/pen (List # of pens on entry form)

PREMIUMS:

Of head 1 or 2: 1st-\$10; 2nd-\$5
3 to 5: 1st-\$20; 2nd-\$15; 3rd-\$10
6 to 8: 1st-\$30; 2nd-\$25; 3rd-\$20; 4th-\$15

BREED CHAMPION AWARDS:

All breed champions will receive a rosette plus:

CHAMPION EWE & RAM: \$125 each

RESERVE CHAMPION EWE & RAM: \$75 each

SUPREME CHAMPION EWE & RAM: \$300 each

RESERVE SUP. CHAMPION EWE & RAM: \$200 each
